

## **Eagle Community Credit Union Donates \$10K to Ukrainian Credit Union Displacement Fund**

*Members and Local Residents Can Also Donate*

**Foothill Ranch, CA (March 31, 2022):** Eagle Community Credit Union has donated \$10,000 to the Ukrainian Credit Union Displacement Fund through the Worldwide Foundation of Credit Unions to directly support short and long-term impacts to Ukraine's credit union system, including displaced credit union employees, members, and challenges to the country's credit union system over the long term.

“Credit unions are about helping people helping people,” said CEO Scott Rains. “With the events unfolding in Ukraine, many people are suddenly refugees with no place to call home. This donation, along with others from the credit union movement, will assist Ukrainian credit union members and employees with much needed assistance.”
